Request for Transportation

Welcome to MCA's bus transportation. We are pleased to offer this absolutely free to you! If, however, you would like to make contributions to offset this expenditure for the school, please ask the driver for an envelope. The school will then furnish you with an acknowledgement for your donation.

The bus will wait five minutes at each stop. For the afternoon route, if there is no one at the stop to pick up a child, after five minutes the driver will return the child to school and place him in the care of the Lion's Watch. Parents must pick up the child and pay the required fee.

MCA requires the same deportment on a bus that it requires in school. Students are to follow the instructions of the bus driver and monitor, adhering to the Honor Code, as well as the school's Expectations and Character Habits.

In case of inclement weather, school may be in session, but bus transportation will not be provided if the roads prohibit a safe drive. In such situations, parents are to secure transportation for their own children. As always, if parents determine the roads are unsafe even for their own vehicles, they are not to attempt the drive to Mount Airy. Parents should let their children's teachers know of the circumstances, once travel is safe.

Special directions for riding the bus:

- Students should arrive at the bus stop on time and wait in the car with an adult.
- Students wait until the bus comes to a complete stop before attempting to board.
- Students walk, not run, when boarding or exiting from the bus.
- Students remain seated while the bus is in motion and will not obstruct the isles with legs, feet, or other objects.
- Students are not allowed to eat or drink (except water) on the bus.
- Students stay seated while the bus is in motion, and are not to put any part of their body (i.e. hands, arms, legs, head) out the windows.
- Students will keep the bus clean.
- Boys and girls in grades K-3 may sit together. Males and females in grades 4-12 may not.

Riding the bus is a privilege and not a right. If a student's bus privileges are revoked due to violation of this policy, it remains the responsibility of the parent or guardian to transport the student to and from school.
